South Africa's Garden Route is one of those rare journeys — a ribbon of tarmac where ocean, forest, and mountain collide, and every mile feels alive with possibility.

From the moment you leave Cape Town, the landscape begins to unfold in layers: dramatic coastal cliffs washed by the Atlantic, mountain passes carved into ancient stone, and sweeping bends that draw you effortlessly into the ride. The air carries salt and pine, and the road flows with a rhythm that feels less ridden and more felt.

The days lead you through places rich with contrast — quiet fishing towns, endless beaches, deep indigenous forests, and open plains where the horizon stretches wide. You ride beneath towering peaks and alongside rolling surf, through passes where every corner reveals another view worth slowing for, another moment worth remembering.

Inland, the land shifts again. Dry air, wide valleys, and hidden wonders beneath the earth itself — where ancient caves open into cathedral-like chambers, shaped over millions of years. Wildlife moves freely beyond the fences of the road, and the sense of space is intoxicating, grounding you in the scale of the landscape.

This is not just a tour.

It's a journey through one of the most beautiful riding corridors on earth — where adventure meets comfort, and every day delivers something different, something real.

# DAILY ITINERARY

## DAY 1 – CAPE TOWN ARRIVAL

You will arrive in Cape Town and take delivery of rental bikes. Spend the rest of the day taking in a couple of sights in and around Cape Town, we will have a group evening meal with a chance to get to know your fellow adventurers and guide, any doubts concerns or questions now's the time.

## DAY 2 – HERMANUS

Today we will be riding to Hermanus the whale watching capital of the world! stopping at Gansbai on route for our White Shark cage dive. After checking into the hotel we will spend the afternoon watching the southern right whales who can be found in and around the bay.

## DAY 3 – MOSSEL BAY

today we head along the coast to the picturesque Mossel Bay today is a riding day as we head East towards the Garden Route national park. the afternoon will be spent taking in the sights in and around Mossel Bay.

## DAY 4 – SCHOTIA

Today we will ride to Schotia via the Stunning Garden Route National park! expect awesome scenery and breath taking roads!. after signing in we will ride in the park to our accommodation watching for elephants giraffe kudu and other African wildlife, once we are parked and changed out of riding gear our ranger will pick us up and we will have a full safari by open jeep getting really close to Africa's big 5, we will be taken to our bush lapa to enjoy an evening meal before continuing with a night drive. The next day begins with a morning drive and breakfast then we collect our bikes for the next leg of our journey.

## DAY 5 – OUDTSHOORN

Today we ride to the ostrich capital of Africa and the chance to explore the cango caves a 20 million year old network of limestone chambers.

## DAY 6 – CAPE AGHULLAS

Today we ride the famous R62 from Oudtshoorn to Cape Aghullas the southern most point on the continent of Africa! we will stop at Ronnies Sex Shop (its not what you think) a famous pit stop on the R62 famed for its many undergarments hanging from the ceiling left by past patrons, continuing on we will ride alongside the Langeberg mountains heading towards the biking mecca that is the Kogmanskloofpass here you will experience amazing tarmac and endless twisties as we edge ever closer to the southern coast. the evening will be spent visiting the monument at Cape Aghullas.

## DAY 7 – SIMONS TOWN

Today we follow the coast road (the R44) to Simons town this road is famed for its pristine tarmac and extraordinary views of South Africa's coastline (some say this is the most beautiful road in South Africa) passing the iconic towns of Gansbaai and Betty's Bay to name a few.

Tonight is spent in the beautiful coast setting of Simons town (a seaside town with a difference), at our hotel you will be surprised to see wild African penguins and even get the chance to swim with them in the rock pools.

## DAY 8 – CAPE TOWN

After your early morning swim with the penguins we will ride to The Cape of Good Hope and then on to the amazing Chapman's Peak drive back to Cape Town and return our bikes this is where our adventure ends unless you have chosen to spend some extra time in Cape Town just let us know and we will arrange tours and hotels.
